

## LIST OF BOATS

9 All boats sailing in Club matches shall if requested by the Sailing Committee, provide a certificate of measurement from the local official measurer.

10 A protest on the score of a breach of the Rules occurring during a race must be signified by showing a flag conspicuously in the main rigging of the protesting boat at the first opportunity when passing the officer of the day, unless the competitor has no knowledge of the facts justifying the protest until after the conclusion of the race. All protests must be made in writing and must name the rule or rules alleged to have been broken. The protest must be signed by the owner or his representative and lodged with the Sailing Committee together with a fee of 2s 6d. within two hours of the finish of the race, such fee to be forfeited to the Club should the Sailing Committee so decide.

11 The time limit for finishing all inshore races shall be before the tide leaves the shore.

12 Sailing instructions will be placed on the board in the Club Room at least one hour before the race to which they apply.

13 Challenge Cups may only be won by boats which have competed in at least three previous L.S.C. races during the same season.

14 Prizes—2nd and 3rd prizes will not be given unless 4 or 6 boats respectively compete.

Members are specially requested to carry on their sails the numbers allocated to them.
