The times of High Water are Clock Time.

The times of High Water at Whitstable, Hartly Ferry, Queenboro', Cockham Woods, Benfleet, Holehaven and Southend are approximately the same as at Leigh.

The times of High Water at Dover are approximately 1 hour earlier than at Leigh.

The times and heights of High Water may differ considerably from those predicted owing to the effects of winds, atmospheric pressure, flood water, etc.
