#### 14. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT.

The Honorary Secretary shall keep a record of the affairs of the Club and at the Annual General Meeting shall submit a Statement of Accounts for the previous financial year ending 31st December, duly certified by two Honorary Auditors, who shall be elected annually. A copy of such Statement of Accounts shall be posted on the Notice Board five clear days before the Annual General Meeting.

#### 15. MINUTES OF MEETINGS.

Minutes of the proceedings of all General and Committee Meetings shall be entered in a book kept for that purpose and shall be signed by the Chairman.

#### 16. INFRINGEMENT OF RULES.

Should any member infringe the rules or bye-laws of the Club, the Committee shall have power to deal with such member as they in their absolute discretion think fit.

#### 17. ALTERATION OF RULES.

The Rules shall not be altered, added to or rescinded, without the sanction of at least two thirds of the members present and voting at an Annual or Special General Meeting. Notice of any proposed alteration of the Rules shall be given in the Agenda of the General Meeting.
