SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- All races shall be sailed under the rules of the I.Y.R.U. and the R.Y.A.
- Crews of yachts under 8 tons (T.M.) shall consist wholly of amateurs and the number of persons in yachts of 5 ton (T.M.) and under shall not exceed four.
- All yachts taking part in any race shall be under the direction of the Officer-of-the-Day or, in his absence, that of a member of the Sailing Committee.
- The Officer-of-the-Day or the Sailing Committee shall have the power to shorten the course or postpone any race.
- Prior to a yacht's first race a Form of Entry must be completed giving particulars of hull, rig, etc. In addition, yachts must be entered for every race on the appropriate list on the Club Sailing Notice Board. Such entry to be made by 9 p.m. on the day preceding the event.
- A declaration must be made in accordance with I.Y.R.U. Rule No. 16. Signatures should be affixed in the adjacent column to the yacht's name on the List of Entry.
- Entries and Entrance Fees of all visiting yachts, must be in the hands of the Sailing Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the race to which they apply. The Entrance Fees of all yachts registered in this Club become due immediately succeeding the last race in the season, and will be assessed from the Lists of Entry.
- Each yacht shall carry a distinguishing flag in accordance with I.Y.R.U. Rule 17, Part 2.
- Recalls. A Sound Signal will be made. The onus for returning and crossing the Line in the proper manner will be with the yacht concerned.
- Where Courses are abbreviated, they must be complied with in the spirit of I.Y.R.U. (Rule 29).
- Cancelled and postponed races. See I.Y.R.U. Rule 7. (excepting paras. 3(b) and 3(c)).
- The Course number will be exhibited on the board at the Starting Hut.
- All races are "open" events.
